**College Board Trustee Chris Jackson  
Announces His Run for Board of Supervisors, District 10**

On Tuesday, May 4, Chris Jackson will file papers with the Department of Elections to run for the Board of Supervisors, District 10. Chris Jackson currently sits on the Community College Board, serving as that body's Budget Chair.

"I am proud to run to represent the diverse communities of District 10 on the Board of Supervisors," Chris Jackson said. "It is a place my family has called home since 1966. My candidacy will focus on how we can make our neighborhoods safer and more family-friendly. Our district is in a place of transition, and we need responsible leadership that will advocate for smart growth and good-paying jobs."

In 2008, Chris Jackson was elected to the Community College Board, garnering over 8,000 votes in District 10 alone. He is the only elected African-American male in San Francisco. Chris Jackson currently works for the San Francisco Labor Council as a policy analyst.

District 10 is comprised of the neighborhoods of the Southeast: Potrero Hill, Bayview Hunters Point, Visitation Valley, and Portola. There are 16 declared supervisorial candidates running in District 10.
